

**Classroom Information Sheet**

Here are some useful details for summer term, including dates for your diary and information relating to our classroom routines. As always, if you have any questions, however big or small, please don't hesitate to get in touch. Thank you for your support. **Miss Field**

**PE, Games and Forest School**

**P.E.** – will take place every Tuesday. Children should come into school wearing their P.E. kit.

**Games** – will take place every Friday. Children should come into school wearing their school uniform and bring their P.E. kit to change into. *Please note, games lessons take place outside. It is important that children are able to change back into their clean uniform once the lesson is complete.*

**Forest school** – will take place every Wednesday. Children should come into school wearing their school uniform and bring their forest school kit with them. This should include wellies (or suitable outdoor shoes), long trousers, a long sleeve top and waterproofs. *Although it is summer, the weather can still be changeable so please do send your children with waterproofs as part of their forest school kit. Lightweight, breathable, long sleeve tops are also recommended for warmer summer weather.*

**Homework**

Homework will include:

- **Reading:** children should record their reading daily and read with an adult at least 3 x per week.
- **Spelling:** complete one activity each week. There are suggested activities at the front of the spelling homework books.
- **Maths:** complete one test page each week
- **Times Table Practice:** daily practice on TTRS

**Daily times table practice is essential this term as children will need to consolidate all multiplication facts up to 12x12 in preparation for the national Multiplication Tables Check which will take place from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> June.**

Homework will be set on Monday and is due in the following Monday. Please ensure children have their homework in their book bags on a Monday morning.

Children will record the homework that has been set each week in their homework diaries. They will also make a note of any other important messages or events for that coming week.

**Please sign your child's homework diary every week. You are welcome to leave comments or record messages in the given box.**

**How you can support**

There are many ways you can help to ensure your child has a successful term, including:

- Ensure children arrive on time; children should be settled at their tables and ready to learn by 08:55am
- Make sure your child knows where they are going at the end of the day
- Inform the school office before 9.00am if your child will be absent from school
- Send your children to school with a water bottle (sports cap) and a fruit snack for break time
- Support and encourage your child to complete their homework
- Sign their homework diaries every week
- Make sure children bring their maths and spelling homework with them every Monday; reading records and homework diaries should be sent into school every day
- Read with your child at least 3 times per week; record this reading in their reading records
- Discuss Picture News at home

***Please note:** School attendance is vital in ensuring your child feels settled in school and able to achieve their full potential. Children are expected to attend school every day unless there is an illness that prevents them from attending or exceptional circumstances that have been discussed and agreed with the head teacher.*
