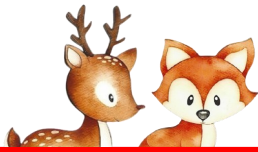

Here's to many more happy weeks ahead!

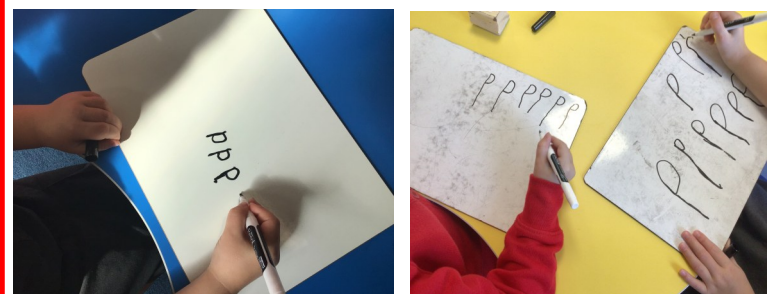
