Summary of Discussion:

Each class shared their feedback about the 'How Do You Feel' Survey. There was a general consensus that there should be more options of responses representing a greater range of feelings.

Children also made suggestions about further questions including:

- How do you feel about coming to school?
- How do you feel at home?
- Which staff member makes you feel safe?
- Are you able to participate in the clubs you would like to?
- Do you enjoy the clubs that you do?
- Do the children in your class share with you?

Key stage 2 wanted more probing questions allowing for an open response, e.g. take a moment to reflect on yourself and your qualities- what are your best qualities? Would you like to set yourself a target of a quality/ value to work on?

Are you worried about anything?

The children shared ideas from their classes about the signs that they would like to have added to the playground.

Red/ Green sign to indicate if someone was already in the toilet/ filling up a drink; Walking zone; Reading corner sign- near Nursery; Motivational messages for daily mile; kindness messages; Inclusive signs; BSL; Maze on the wall; Buddy stop; Rules for games; Game suggestion; Fitness challenges; Safety notices e.g. don't run across the football pitch; information about animals/ birds; Times tables; Space Information; Different languages; world maps; timelines.

Actions:

- Mrs Cowley to complete minutes and email out to teachers.
- Mrs Cowley produce draft questionnaire (and send to classes for children to share and reflect on).
- Mrs Cowley to write a newsletter update.
- Yr 6 reps sort a folder for reception for meetings.
- Children to continue gathering ideas for equipment to improve the playground (we will discuss this next time).
- When the draft questionnaire arrives in class children to share and make notes on further improvements that they feel need to be made.
