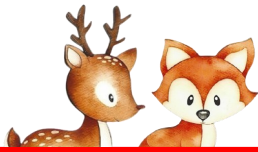

Night Time Numbers: Counting With Creatures

This week in Reception, we've been diving into the wonderful world of numbers through lots of hands-on, playful activities – all inspired by our theme of nocturnal animals and autumn.

Our focus has been on understanding what makes a number, especially looking closely at numbers up to 5.

The children have been exploring cardinality – learning that the last number in a count tells us “how many” there are altogether.

Through sorting, matching, and building sets using animal counters, natural materials, and themed games, the children have been discovering all the different ways numbers can be made.
