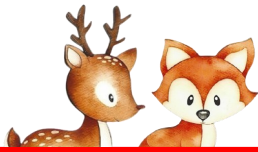

Thanks to our phonics teaching using the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised programme, the children have learned the first set of sounds (Phase 2) and are now bringing books home to share with you.

At school, children continue to practise phonics daily, blending sounds to read words and developing fluency.
