### **Dress rehearsals**

Our dress rehearsal will be on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December at 9.30pm. If your child does not usually attend Friday morning sessions, please bring them along for 8.45am prompt. They will need to be collected at approximately 10.30 am from the red gate.

### **Performances**

Our first performance will take place on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December at 2.00pm. If your child does not usually attend Wednesday sessions, please bring them to Nursery for 1.00pm. You will be met at the red gates. Please be prompt.

Our second performance will be on 12<sup>th</sup> December at 9.30am. ALL children will need to be at nursery by 8.45am prompt. They can be taken home at the end of the performance or if they usually stay all day, they can be collected at 3.15pm. **School uniform must be worn to the rehearsal and final productions.**

Many thanks for your flexibility during the Christmas period. As children attend different sessions; it can be very difficult to co-ordinate performances to ensure we have a full cast.

If you have any questions regarding any of the above, please do not hesitate to speak to me.

During letters and sounds we have introduced the letters o, c, k. The children have revisited all of the previous sounds to date (s a t p i n m d g). You can support your child at home by revisiting the sounds 'little and often' each day.
